



Hylton Castle and Town End Farm Boxing Club Parental Code of Conduct

As a parent/guardian/carer of a member who is actively involved with the Hylton Castle and Town End Farm Boxing Club OR a parent/guardian/carer of a travelling boxer (on such occasions as evenings of boxing held in the club, it is expected that you appropriately follow the “Parental Code of Conduct” below:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all participants.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements/decisions.
- Always support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Always use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
